

The Shivaji University Act, 1962

(MAHARASHTRA ACT No. XXVIII OF 1962)

(An Act to establish and incorporate a teaching and affiliating University at Kolhapur to be known as the Shivaji University.)

WHEREAS, it is expedient to establish and incorporate teaching and affiliating University at Kolhapur to be known as the Shivaji University as a measure in the further decentralisation and reorganization of University education in the State of Maharashtra; It is hereby enacted in the Thirteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

CHAPTER I

Preliminary

1. (1) This Act may be called the Shivaji University Act 1962.

Short title and commencement.

(2) This section shall come into force at once.

(3) The State Government may, by notification in the *Official Gazette*, direct that all or any of the remaining provisions of this Act shall come into force on such date or dates, as may be specified in the notification.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—

Definitions.

(1) "affiliated" means affiliated under sections 34 and 35;

(2) "degree college or "college" means an affiliated college which is authorised to submit its students to an examination qualifying for any degree of the University;

(3) "high school" means a high school which has been recognised as a fullfledged high school by the Director of Education Maharashtra State or by an officer authorised by him in this behalf and includes a multipurpose high school so recognised or a high school situate outside the State of Maharashtra which has been recognised by the University;

(4) "hostel" means a unit of residence for students of the University, maintained or recognised by the University under this Act
